The school is affiliated by **CBSE**, **Code no- 35409 Sl-no. 00224-1718/2017** and recognized by the Department of Education. Govt. up to High School. The institution is Coeducational. The medium of instruction is English while Hindi & Bengali is taught as second language.

It aims to give children a sound, Physical, Intellectual, Moral and Spiritual education. Since this school is a Non-Government Organization run by the society- "Ebenezer Hamkrai Society", it follows and abides also by the rules and regulation and aims and objects of the society.

And also it is attached with the Boarding House of Rev. Manprasad Memorial Boys and Girls Hostel. At present there are 300 nos. of approved seat of Boarding House approved by the Tribal Welfare Department, Govt. of Tripura

<u>Pattern:</u> The School includes classes from Kg- I to Class X. The curriculum of the CBSE is followed. English is the medium of instruction while Bengali & Hindi is the second language.

Academic Year and Timings:

The school academic year commences in April and ends in March. Timings: 8: 00 Am to 1:00 Pm.



These timings are subject to change whenever necessary; it may not always be possible to intimate the change in advance.

Admission Regulations:

Eligibility of age for admission to Kg- I (52 months) i.e. 4 years plus as on April. 1st Together with the application, a photo copy of the birth certificate obtained is to be submitted. In case of higher classes, a transfer certificate from the school last attended is required which should be duly counter signed by the concerned authority. All the above admissions will be subjected to a test of capacity by means of oral and written tests. Admission and assignments to a particular section of the class are entirely reserved to the school authorities. The correct date of birth is to be given at the time of admission.

No change in the date of birth will be entertained. The date of birth once registered cannot be altered.

Rules for payment of School Fees:





- 1. The School Fees cover twelve calendar months. No reduction is made for Holidays or broken periods.
- 2. No students will be allowed to sit for any examination unless all school dues have been cleared before the respective examination.
- 3. Fees will have to be paid as long as pupils name is on the roll.
- 4. The School fees and other dues are liable to be revised when found needed.
- 5. Certificates will be withheld from pupils who have arrears of fees.
- 6. Pupils joining or leaving the School during the year will have to pay for the entire Year.
- 7. Parents/guardians can also deposit all the fees at a time in the beginning of the year.
- 8. Students can pay the online mode and offline mode of payment.

Vacations

The school has two short vacations for Christmas and Puja and a long vacation for summer.

Rules and Regulations of the syllabus and assessment of students' performance are in accordance with the standard set by the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE), New Delhi.

Examinations:

There will be Four Exam like PT- 1 & PT- II for 20 Mark & FA 1 & FA 2 for 80 marks.

- a) Regularity in attendance. (Minimum 90% attendance)
- b) Quality of day today participation in class.
- c) Written work and projects assigned by the subject teacher.
- d) Satisfactory performance at the class tests.
- e) A progress report is shown to parents/ Guardians after the PT-I, PT-II, Half yearly Exam & Annual Exam. However, only result are declared after the Annual Exam. Progress Report is normally not shown to any one after the Final Exam. Parents/Guardians are requested to sign the progress report and to evaluate the performance of the students after the half yearly exam.

Leaves Rules

- 1. Leave of absence will be granted only for serious reasons on previous written application from parents or guardians.
- 2. In case of absence without leave, the students, on returning to the school, must produce the reason of absence certificate from his/her parents or guardians. If any pupil has been absent for more than 3 days, he/she should not enter the class without first obtaining permission from the Principal. A student returning to School after contracting a contagious of infectious disease should produce a Doctor's fitness certificate permitting him/her to attend classes, without any danger to other students.

Special Activities

It is our earnest desire to make each child **GOOD AND SMART.** In order to achieve the above, we incorporate many educational activities during the academic year. One among them is Saturday special activities where students are exposed to varied endeavours to bring out the best in them. We make it compulsory from class Kg- to Class- X knowing that they will be enthusiastic to develop and expand their talents and capabilities to their fullest extent during their school years. Discipline Rule

- 1. Pupils are expected to regularly prepare their lessons & do their homework. Those who have not done their homework will not be allowed to sit in the class.
- **2.** It is obligatory to wear the uniform prescribed for the season on class days and at a School functions.
- **3.** Those who are not correctly dressed in conformity with the regulations of the school will not be admitted to the class.
- 4. Except for reasons of ill health and unavoidable circumstances, a previous written application from the guardian is required for any leave of absence. If any pupil has been absent for more than 3 (three) days, he/she should not enter the class without first obtaining permission from the principal.
- **5.** Any pupil who is absent himself/herself for more than one calendar month without a written permission from the principal shall have his/her name stuck off the rolls. To be re-admitted he/she will have to pay fresh admission fees as well as all fees for the said period of absence.
- **6.** 90% attendance in a class is required for promotion to the next higher class.
- **7.** Those who do not report to class for one week after the vacation will have their names stuck off the rolls. The Principal reserves the right to consider applications for the readmission of such pupils.

- **8.** Pupils should treat classrooms as sacred places. They are expected to maintain silence an order in the classrooms. Those who disturb the class will be sent out of the class rooms. During the absence of a teacher from the class pupils must obey the leader appointed to maintain good order.
- **9.** Running playing or shouting in the School building are not permitted. During the class hours pupils should move along the corridors in silence and order.
- **10.** Participation in games, physical training, cultural activities and socially useful productive works are compulsory. Exemption will be granted on medical ground only.
- **11.** Pupils are strictly forbidden to form any association or to engage themselves in any group activity or to raise funds for any purpose without the permission of the Principal or any other staff authorized by him on his behalf.
- **12.** Pupils are not allowed to buy, sell or exchange any articles among themselves in the School Premises.
- 13. No one should write on the furniture or walls or damage any school articles. Damage by accident should be reported to the Principal at once. Any damage caused to school property or to the property of another student must be compensated with money or by replacing the said product.
- **14.** Pupils shall not circulate books, magazines or periodicals in the school without the permission of the Principal.
- **15.** Irregular attendance, habitual idleness, theft, dishonesty, immoral conduct, insubordination, neglect of homework, disobedience or disrespect towards the members of the staff, unruly behaviour or immoral influence justify dismissal.
- **16.** English should be spoken in the school premises at all times in order to acquire fluency in speaking the language.
- **17.** Without the written permission from the Principal, pupils will not be allowed to leave the school during school hours.
- 18. Pupils of this school are not permitted to bring Mobile Phones, Electronic gadgets, unauthorized CDs, Cameras, Fancy watches and Gold ornaments and other valuable goods to the school. Once seized such things will not be returned.
- **19.** Those who do not come to the School with proper uniform will be fined.
- 20. Students are to show discipline in their hair style. Boys are to closely trim their hair and girls need to tie their hair with ribbon properly.

KG- I: (Admission to the Classes)

- # During the 2nd week of November & January registration forms will be available in the school office for admission to various classes.
- # The eligibility age for the admission to the Kg- I, will be 4 years plus (4 + i.e, 52 months completed) as on the 1st April. Together with (his registration form a duly attested photocopy of the birth certificate must be submitted.
- # At the time of interview and admission the parents of the candidate must be present. They are Excepted to produce original Birth Certificate, and related documents to make sure that the candidate fulfils the requirements. Both the parents are supposed to sign in the admission form.

KG- I to Class IX: (Admission to the class KG- I to Cl- IX)

- # Parents who wish to admit their children to Kg- I and above must fill up the forms and submit the same in the School Office.
- # Admission will be judged on the basis of the **ORAL** and **Written Test.** The correct **Date** of **Birth** must be given at the time of Admission. No changes in the date of birth will entertained later on.
- # At the time of interview and admission, the parents of the candidate must be present. They are expected to produce **Original Birth Certificate**, **Transfer Certificate** and **Progress Report** from the school last attended.
